## **NATIONAL PUERTO RICAN DAY PARADE, INC. MISS PUERTO RICO-NPRP APPLICATION**

**This experience provides young women who participate with an opportunity to learn about their roots and develop pride in their culture, language and heritage. Contestants must meet age, educational and cultural eligibility criteria to qualify for participation in the Pageant.**

**All potential applicants must submit a complete application and photo with a \$10.00 processing fee. A preliminary screening process will take place and all applicants will be advised of acceptance. Upon acceptance, a participation fee of \$250.00 is required to be paid in full. Only money orders or bank checks will be accepted.**

**Qualified applicants will be prepped for the competition during the month of May. The winner will be selected by a panel of Judges that will evaluate achievements, personality and cultural awareness throughout the required segments of the competition.**

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- **Age 18 - 25 years old**
- **Must be of Puerto Rican heritage**
  - **Must be single, no children**
- **Must be bilingual (Spanish/English)**
  - **Must be student or graduate**
- **Must not be participating in any other pageant**

## MISS PUERTO RICO-NPRP APPLICATION

Contestants and their parents/guardians agree to hold harmless all persons affiliated with the Miss Puerto Rico-NPRP Pageant (Herein after "MPR-NPRP ") and the National Puerto Rican Day Parade, Inc, in case of any loss or injury occurring during, or in travel to and/or from any program or event affiliated with MPR-NPRP or the National Puerto Rican Day Parade, Inc.

Entrants hereby agree to release unconditionally and forever, any claim against MPR-NPRP and the National Puerto Rican Day Parade, Inc., its officers, directors, employees, agents, subsidiaries, which they may have, by virtue of their participation in this pageant or any use of their name, likeness, voice and/or biography in connection with this pageant, including use in promotional and advertising material.

Photographs, video and/or sound recordings taken of contestants before, during and after the pageant, by pageant officials or their designees, will become the exclusive property of MPR-NPRP and may be used for publicity and other purposes as the MPR-NPRP deems fit.

If for any reason a winner is disqualified, or elects not to participate, her title and all awards including crown and sash, trophy and prizes will be returned to the National Office and given to the next choice of the judges. By signing this document contestants hereby understand that the contestant whose title is relinquished or who is disqualified shall be responsible for any and all court costs, and attorney's fees incurred by MPR-NPRP in an effort to have the aforementioned property returned to the pageant.

Crowns and sashes remain the property of MPR-NPRP. Any contestant who defaults, in any way, must return all prizes and awards including her crown and sash to the National Puerto Rican Day Parade office, within ten (10) business days of receiving official notice of such default. All crown, sashes and prizes must be returned to the office in the condition in which it was received.

Any contestant may withdraw from the competition at any time, however, in doing so, must return the crown, sash and all prizes and awards to the National Puerto Rican Day Parade office, within ten (10) business days after said withdraw.

Under no circumstances, and not for any reason, shall any participant be entitled to a refund in whole or in part of any fees paid. All fees paid to MPR-NPRP are NOT REFUNDABLE and NOT TRANSFERABLE in full or in part under any circumstances. This includes, but is not limited to entry fees, advertising fees, pageant admission ticket sales fees, guest meal fees and any other fees paid to MPR-NPRP by anyone including, but not limited to, delegates, sponsors, and advertisers.
